

Annual event with international reach

The Sommerakademie at the Zentrum Paul Klee takes place each year during ten days in August. It is a platform for contemporary art with thematic workshops and promotes the production, reflection and the transmission of art. A characteristic feature of the Sommerakademie is its lack of compulsory production. It is unaffiliated to any specific educational system and defines its raison d'être as offering a group of international participants, artists, curators and critics, the opportunity to concentrate on fundamental questions and ideas together. This enables the young Fellows to explore new paths. The public is invited to participate in the public events.

The activities of the Sommerakademie are an integral part of the basic general concept of the Zentrum Paul Klee. The Sommerakademie represents the Cantonal Bank of Berne's BEKB | BCBE (Berner Kantonalbank AG) commitment to training.

Concept and artistic direction



This year's Guest Curator is Raimundas Malašauskas (Lithuania). He is an author and curator with projects all over the world. In 2012 he was a member of the curatorial team of the documenta 13 in Kassel, in 2013 he curated the Lithuanian and Cypriot pavilions at the Biennale in Venice.

Theme "HR"



This year's Sommerakademie will explore Hermann Rorschach's psychodiagnostic inkblot tests and visit the Hermann Rorschach archive at the Institute of the History of Medicine at the University of Berne and the Psychiatry Museum Bern.

In the case of Rorschach the connection between art and science

proved to be an exceptional undertaking which led to many controversial issues. One doesn't have to look far to reach this intersection. The city of Berne is a tight mix of art, science and medicine. Albert Einstein developed his Theory of Relativity here; Harald Szeemann directed the Kunsthalle with exhibitions on the quest for new conceptual and sensory territories; psychiatry and fairy tale met during the dream time of Hermann Rorschach.

The Fellows will be working in the Botanical Garden of the University of Berne in the midst of an inspiring collection of species.

Jury, Nominators, Fellows and Speakers

For 2014 the Sommerakademie received 160 applications of which 77 came from nominations and 83 were free submissions. Nominators from the national and international art world, alumni and former guest curators may nominate one artist, curator or critic per year for participation. The close connection of the applicant's work to the yearly theme as well as their originality and the complexity of their work are decisive criteria for the selection of participants. The twelve Fellows from ten different countries reflect the international focus of the Sommerakademie. Each year the Sommerakademie invites prominent international speakers to Berne to hold workshops and give lectures.
