Annual event with international reach

The Sommerakademie im Zentrum Paul Klee takes place every year during ten days in August. It is an annual international platform for contemporary art with themed workshops that fosters artistic productivity and reflection as well as the promotion of art. The Sommerakademie is special in that it enables an international group of artists, curators and art critics to explore fundamental questions and ideas together. It is tied neither to an artistic output nor a specific educational system. This allows the young Fellows to discover new avenues. The public is invited to attend the the public events.

The activities of the Sommerakademie im Zentrum Paul Klee are an integral part of the general concept of the Zentrum Paul Klee. The Sommerakademie im Zentrum Paul Klee represents the Cantonal Bank of Berne's BEKB | BCBE (Berner Kantonalbank AG) commitment to training.

Theme and Guest Curator

The Sommerakademie 2015 is guest curated by Egyptian curator Hassan Khan. He is an artist, musician and writer with projects across the globe. He lives in Cairo.

My first intuitive response to the invitation (by the Sommerakademie im Zentrum Paul Klee) was that I didn't want to come up with a totalizing theme, but rather to develop an approach. I want to engage with the Fellows directly through what the various (very diverse) guests would bring to the table. Rather than foreground one big statement that we all have to respond to, let's focus on what working with different approaches can potentially allow.

Theme "Teaser"

Over the span of ten days this meeting of minds, forum for questions, space of engagements and focus, this respite, this arena of distraction will aim to offer a gentle hook. Is it a smooth dissolve or a harsh cut? A melodic harmony or an atonal storm? Formal virtuosity or a wild ramble?

Sometimes we need to begin with questions and answers. What has been labelled early twentieth century modernism has never been digested or understood. So what kind of artist do you think you are? It is, sometimes for some people, important to trick ourselves. Who is it that speaks when you decide that something has value? Engagement and loss are real and possible. What is a context? Sometimes everything you know can be put into brackets.

What is value? Focusing on what one does can be incredibly rewarding. What kind of relationship do we hold to what surrounds us, to what we do and what we want? Capitalism does not exist. How can we know what is important and what merely greases the wheels of function? What do we do with the ever-evolving questions of form, function and content, the shadow of meaning that haunts us? How to determine a measure of good faith? How not to lose self-respect? What are the lessons of what we call art history, what are its limits and how is it being redefined by some of those who have engaged the beast?

Teaser is ten days spent within the relative comfort and pleasures of institutional support. Ten days of possible explorations, ego massages, and put downs. We will aim to produce different contexts and situations, to stare into the black holes of assumptions and to, sometimes, have a good time.

Jury, Nominators, Fellows and Speakers

This year the jury considered 113 applications of which 66 were nominations and 47 free submissions. National and international Nominators with a respected place in the art world as well as Alumni and former Guest Curators may nominate one artist, curator or art critic for the upcoming academy. The close connection of the applicant's work to the yearly theme is a decisive criterion for the selection of participants along with a professional attitude in the sense of autonomy and complexity. The twelve Fellows from many different countries reflect the Sommerakademie's international focus. Each year renowned international Speakers are invited to Bern to teach workshops and give lectures.
